



Established in Mercurey in the heart of the Burgundian Côte Chalonnaise, Maison Antonin Rodet cultivates since 1875, a 90-hectare vineyard over the appellation but also on the villages of Rully, Maranges, Santenay and over the Hautes-Côtes de Beaune area. In this exceptional environment, bordered with two emblematic castles in Rully and Mercey together with the Domaine de la Bressande, the unique terroirs of Southern Burgundy express themselves marvellously. Of noble character and fully expressive after traditional winemaking, the Antonin Rodet wines reflect their origins with great purity.

History

Nuits-Saint-Georges is a communal appellation, producing 300 ha of red wines including 41 Premier Cru "climats". White wines represent only 7 ha.

Clos de Thorey is located in the north of Nuits-Saint-Georges. This plot is situated in the middle and top of the slope, with good exposure (east / southeast) and a light limestone soil, stony and well-drained, and extends over 3 hectares.

The vines are aged from 30 to 50 years old.

Wine and food pairing

This wine goes well with duck breast, meat sauce and foie gras.

Serving temperature

15° C - 16° C

Decant one hour before tasting to reveal all the aromas of this wine.
